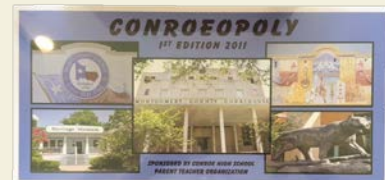

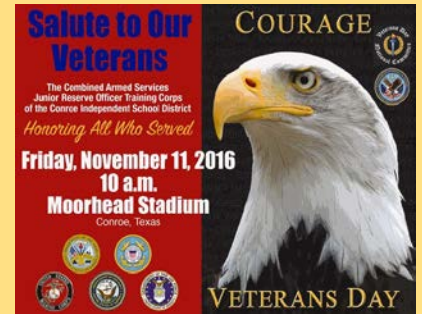
CHS will also have 8 students singing in the TMEA Region 9 Honor Choir.
