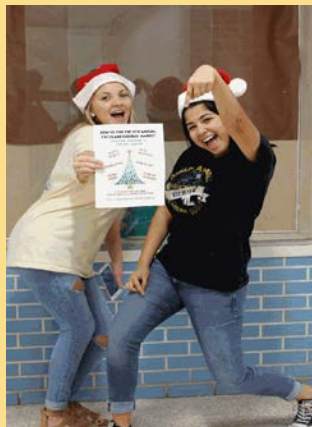

### **Our CHS TRAILS Program:**

**T.R.A.I.L.S** is a Conroe Independent School District service delivery model for students 18-22 who have completed graduation requirements but are in need of skills related to adulthood to become productive citizens in their communities. The model encompasses the following components: daily living skills, school based enterprise, recreation and leisure, social skills training, community based instruction trips, and vocational training.

All five high schools have T.R.A.I.L.S. on their campus. T.R.A.I.L.S.- Transition Reflecting Adult Independent Living Skills is a self-funded program. The money that we raise through donations and a Student Based Enterprise selling various items is what we teach them with in the Community. We use that money to buy groceries to cook with and to teach them how to behave at a restaurant and so forth. We find it is vital to utilize all social media outlets to consistently communicate and promote to our students the importance of self-worth and self-acceptance.
